The Challenge

NEHA provides content to anyone in the environmental/public health arena, addressing specific environmental and public health topic areas. Content covers a wide array of environmental/public health topics, such as air quality, food, water supply/safety regulations, daycares, pest control/mosquito abatement, etc. NEHA contacted 6Connex about implementing a virtual conference to allow participants to have instant access to pertinent information.

The Solution

6Connex set out to create an online event in which participants from all environmental health vantage points could receive professional development and training in areas that affect various environmental and public health sectors. In addition to offering training and networking, attendees could access detailed information on state and local regulations and guidelines. Furthermore, the virtual event would provide attendees' with content on highly specialized environmental subjects, which is not easy to achieve in a traditional, physical environment due to budget limitations. For example, many topics in NEHA's virtual conference focused on recreational and aquatic health facilities.

Tracking

In pivoting to a virtual event, NEHA allowed environmental health officials to track how information was received.

Capturing initial registration details and performing engagement analytics informed department leaders of how often their participants were interacting and with which content.

Sharing Crucial Information & Training

NEHA was able to efficiently share valuable information to more than 600 participants. The virtual conference encouraged intense training, providing participants with the opportunity to thoroughly explore every aspect of an environmental subject in detail. In addition, from an environmental health perspective, it is important professionals from all subject areas bring their concerns and knowledge to the table. During the virtual conference, professionals could easily consult with each other without incurring travel expenses or leaving busy work schedules.

The NEHA Virtual Conference consisted of a mix of presenters to make certain everyone was included in the discussions. This was particularly important, as policies, regulations, and inspections impact everyone in the environmental arena. For example, pest management has many facets and during a virtual conference, pest control personnel and university entomologists can come together to discuss how to effectively eliminate mosquitos/ticks. Likewise, food safety includes public health inspectors
